Mr Copley led our whole school worship yesterday. We heard Kieran read Sunday's Gospel reading where Jesus was trying to help His disciples to understand that he is The Good Shepherd. Jesus said "*I have come so that they may have life and have it to the full.*"

We talked about how we could follow Jesus in the same way that sheep follow a shepherd by listening for their leader to 'call' them.

Mr Copley told us a story about how he once saw hundreds of sheep coming down a hillside in Wensleydale with two farmers (or shepherds). He watched them as they got to two gates at the bottom

of the field. One of the farmers whistled and amazingly half the sheep turned to go through a gate. Shortly afterwards the other farmer whistled in a slightly different way and his sheep followed him straight ahead. I'm sure you can imagine it was an incredible sight to see the sheep recognising their leader and following them!

Our mission was to follow The Good Shepherd in our lives by looking after one another and to listen and follow those who lead us and help us.
