# **'TOGETHER WE ARE GROWING TOWARDS GOD'**

Dear Parents, Guardians and Parishioners,

Mrs Haines led worship yesterday which was all about the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant. As with last week's Sunday Gospel, this week's Gospel focused on the importance of forgiveness. Sienna (Y3), Callum (Y4) and Theo (Y5) helped Mrs Haines to re-enact the Parable and help the rest of the school understand Jesus' message. We learned that it doesn't matter how many times someone does something wrong by us, it is important that we forgive them. We also discussed how hard this can be, but no matter how hard, it is always our challenge to try and follow Jesus' way. We ended by praying together, asking Jesus to help us forgive others.



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## New Arrangements for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation

Bishop Marcus has decided that this school year we should begin to change the time when the Sacraments are celebrated with children and young people. There are different ways of doing this all over the world and it is not unusual for changes to be made now and then.

The most obvious change is that from now on First Communion will be celebrated in Year 4 (and not Year 3 as previously). Practically speaking, this means that there will not be any First Communions in our Parish in 2018.

The Bishop has asked that we move to separating out the preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. So those who have just moved into Year 3 (from September 2017) will be invited to prepare for First Reconciliation only and then, when they begin Year 4 in September 2018, they will begin to prepare for First Holy Communion.

Most of us are used to Confirmation being celebrated for young people in Year 9. This is going to change and from September 2018, Confirmation will be celebrated in the first half of Year 6, which means that the children will begin preparing for Confirmation from the summer term of 2018 during Year 5 and (in 2018 only) at the end of Year 6 (for the celebration of Confirmation when they are in Years 6 & 7 respectively). The RE Syllabus will also be adapted to fit in with these changes to sacramental preparation and celebration, to make sure that what your children are learning in their school RE lessons can be linked to the preparation they will have for the sacraments.

This all sounds a little more complicated than it really is and we will try to guide you through the process as much as we can. We will send more details of enrolment and timetables for sacramental preparation in due course.

#### SCHOOL NEWS Reading Books in KS1 and KS2


At St Francis, we take pupil's development in reading very seriously. Due to this fact, we want to ensure that we assess our children accurately at the beginning of each year, and then each half term throughout the year. In KS1, we follow the Big Cat Reading Scheme and in



KS2, we follow the Accelerated Reader Scheme. Unfortunately, we have experienced some technical difficulties with both of the online tools which assess our children on both of these schemes and this has delayed us in being able to assess our children and get them on to the correct reading level for their ability. These difficulties have now been resolved, so please be assured that your child will be assessed over the next week. We apologise for this delay. If your child comes home with a reading book which appears to be a lower level than what he/she had previously, this will be because there is a shift in focus from being able to read the words to having a deep understanding of what the child has read. If you have any feedback for us, either positive or negative, please go through the correct procedures, outlined in the Tuesday News from 5th September 2017.
