

Last Sunday in church, we celebrated the first Sunday of Advent and lit the first candle of the Advent wreath. Our theme in school this

year is **'We Praise You, We Love You, We Thank You.'** We joined together for our first Advent Prayers in the small hall at 8:25am yesterday morning to prepare our hearts and minds for the coming of Our Lord. We reflected upon Sunday's Gospel, whose short but simple message was to 'STAY AWAKE' and be vigilant as we wait for Jesus to come. We decided this would be a fitting mission for us all to try and keep this week. Please note that parents, children, families and parishioners are warmly invited to join us for Advent Prayers every morning at 8:25am. They are just a short 5 or 10 minutes of reflection and are a very calm start to the day. It was lovely to have some of our parents and children join us this morning as we reflected on how patient we have to be in waiting for Jesus to come.

Today, in preparation for Christmas, KS1 will be joined by Fr Anthony to take part in a **Saying Sorry Service** and Ks2 will take part in a **Penitential Service** with Years 4, 5 and 6 having the opportunity to go to confession.

This coming Thursday, 7th December at 9:30am in the large hall is our **Advent Mass**. We welcome all parents, families and parishioners to come along and join us on this special occasion. Groups of children from each year group will be leading different parts of the worship, building on the spiritual experiences we had with the Sion Community during our Mission Week earlier this term. 


