Mr Copley and Mrs Haines' Headteacher's Award was presented to Maisie Hardaker for always applying herself and trying her best in all aspects of school life.


The Big Cat Merit went to Kaitlen Horan for always trying in guided reading and gaining in confidence by volunteering to read out loud in class.
