# READING SURVEY

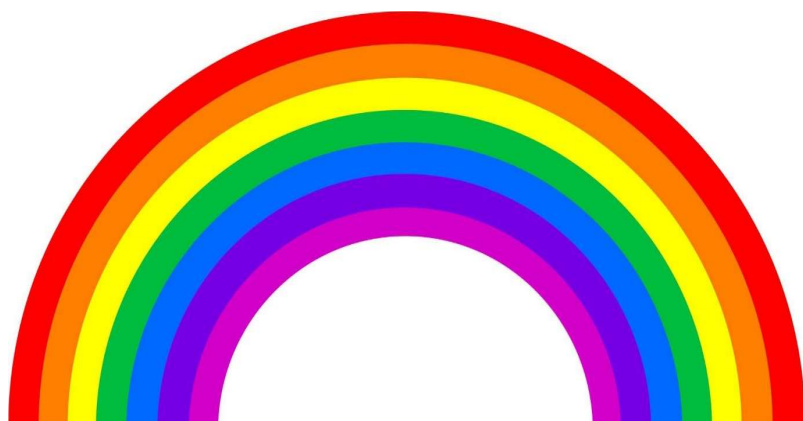

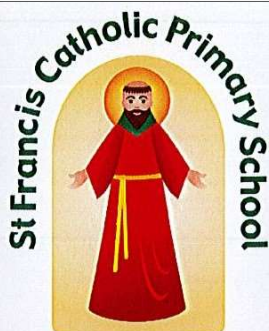




## Nursery Provision
