School Meal Increase

Bradford have announced their new meal charges and from 1^{st} January 2022 the cost of a school meal will be: Nursery: £1.75 for children in F30 class and for Years 3 - 6 £1.95.

This 5p rise is the first increase in our school meals prices since January 2019. School meal prices in the Bradford district remain amongst the lowest in the country, and are

still excellent value for money for a nutritionally balanced 2 course lunch.

Mental Health Champions



Since the Covid 19 pandemic, stress, anxiety and feelings of uncertainty amongst children and young people have been higher than ever. In order to prioritise our children's mental health and raise awareness around this, we have invested in a programme which trains up children to be Mental Health Champions in school. Eight children from each KS2 class have been chosen to take part in the programme, which teaches children and young people how to stay mentally healthy and gives them the skills and tools to be more

resilient. So far the children have taken part in a launch activity over Zoom with many other schools up and down the country and they have taken part in a workshop as the start of their training. We are looking forward to taking part in further training after Christmas and then starting the work as Mental Health Champions.
