## Catholic Life and Collective Worship

Yesterday in worship, we explored Mark's Gospel reading about the transfiguration. Jesus, with three of his disciples, had gone up a mountain to escape the business of the town and the work they had been doing spreading the good news about God. Whilst there, Jesus began to transfigure and Moses and Elijah appeared alongside him. God then spoke to the disciples and told them, "This is my Son, the Beloved." It was a clear sign that Jesus was the Messiah.

Well done and thank you to our chaplains for leading a beautiful worship in EYFS all about the importance of prayer as 'we walk with Christ to the cross' this Lent.




## Thursday 7th March World Book Day
